Harassment and Safety

The Societies are committed to providing a safe and productive environment for everyone present at our meetings. ASA, CSSA, and SSSA prohibit intimidating, threatening, or harassing conduct and this policy applies to everyone associated with the meeting. Meeting participants violating these rules may be asked to leave the meeting (and may not be allowed to attend future meetings) at the discretion of Society leadership. Harassment of any kind is a serious issue, will not be tolerated in any form, and includes the following:

- Offensive comments related to ethnicity, religion, disability, age, economic status, physical appearance, gender, or sexual orientation.
- Deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome attention.

Covid Code of Conduct | *Before Leaving Home*

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the World Health Organization (WHO), or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be travelling to and the region you are travelling from.

On-site During the Event

 - Adhere to social distance protocols put in place by the event organisers and respect others' personal space.
